



ATTENTION HESPERIA CANDIDATES AND TREASURERS

Say Goodbye to all that paper!

The City of Hesperia now provides access to electronic campaign disclosure filing through Netfile, a web-based, data entry filing system that allows candidates and campaign committees to submit disclosure reports mandated by California's Political Reform Act online and free of charge.

Use Netfile to file:

- Form 501 (Declaration of Intent due with Nomination Forms)
- Form 410 (Statement of Organization due when forming a committee)
- Form 460 (Campaign Disclosure due Sept 27, 2018)
- Form 470 (Officeholder/Candidate Campaign Statement due Sept 27, 2018)
- Form 496 (24-hour Independent Expenditures Report due as required)
- Form 497 (24-hour Contribution Report due as required)
- Form 700 (Conflict of Interest Statement due with Nomination Forms)

Now you can save time and file campaign disclosure statements online for free with the FPPC!

Frequently Asked Questions

1) What is e-filing?

E-filing simply means electronically filing required documents instead of filing them on paper. No wet signature required!

2) Why should I e-file my campaign forms

Managing campaign committees and running for office can be time consuming. With e-filing you can input, review, and submit your campaign forms anywhere, anytime.

3) How do I access Netfile?

Easily access Netfile by visiting the URL below
Campaign disclosure forms (Form 460s, 497s, etc) www.cityofhesperia.us/campaign
Statement of Economic Interest (Form 700) www.cityofhesperia.us/SEI



4) What information do I need to register with Netfile?

All you need is an email to register an account. Once you click on "New User? Request Password", it will ask for your email address. A password will be sent to your email address. Use the email you registered with and the automated password from Netfile to login and begin filing

5) What are the advantages of e-filing?

E-filing saves time by avoiding trips to the office to review, sign, and submit campaign forms. When you e-file you are not required to submit a wet signature. If you have a treasurer, they can input the information and submit it on your behalf. Netfile will remember previous filings and fill in all previous information for you, further eliminating extra time and steps.

6) Will my personal information be made public?

When you e-file using Netfile the program automatically protects sensitive information by redacting home address etc. before posting the information to the website as required by the Political Reform Act. However, requests for copies of campaign forms will still be made available to the public with no redactions per the California Political Reform Act.

7) What if I made a mistake and need to file an amendment, or have questions?

Netfile offers easy instructions for filing amendments electronically with on-screen support, tutorials, and a customer help line for technical assistance. If you'd like further assistance, City staff are available as needed.
