Duties: The Non-Represented Animal Care Technician position will care for impounded animals by providing food, water and comfort in a humane and compassionate manner; clean, disinfect and maintain individual animal runs, cages, and animal care facilities; closely observe animal behavior and appearance to identify sick or injured animals; perform and/or assist with the euthanasia of animals. This position performs other duties as required and participates in the City's adjusted workweek schedule including holidays, Saturday and Sunday schedules.

Qualifications: Any combination of education and experience that has provided the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for a Part-Time Animal Care Technician. A typical way of obtaining the required qualifications is to possess the equivalent of six (6) months experience in an animal care environment involving care, handling, and sheltering of animals and/or the performance of related work. Possession of a High School diploma or GED is required. The study of animal science or closely related field courses is desirable. Must be able to complete an approved course and obtain a certificate for euthanizing animals by injection issued by the State of California.

Special Employment Conditions (Part-time):

All part-time/hourly employees are considered at-will and receive the following benefits:

- Sick leave (24 hours per year-eligible for use on the 90th day of employment)
- 457 (b) Deferred Compensation Program available
- Required participation in the Medicare and Social Security programs
- The position will not exceed 960 working hours per fiscal year

TO APPLY: Interested applicants are required to submit a City application. All applications will be screened and only those candidates who best match the needs of the City will be invited to compete further in the selection process. Based on the qualifications from this recruitment's applicant pool, the City will exercise its discretion to determine the weight of testing (100%, pass/fail, or a conversion 40%-60%). Testing may include a written, interview, and/or assessment examination. Applicants will receive notification regarding recruitment status within three (3) weeks of final filing date.
