Duties: The Facilities Maintenance Technician is represented by the Teamsters Local 1932 and will be responsible for performing complex maintenance, limited construction, remodeling, and repair of all designated City owned buildings and facilities. The incumbent assists in ensuring that buildings, offices and publicly accessible areas are maintained in a clean, sanitary and professional setting, and will aid custodial personnel as needed as well as maintaining and repairing facilities involving plumbing, painting, and carpentry duties using small equipment and hand tools. May assist in performing minor repairs to electrical problems, including replacing light bulbs, breakers, outlets, fuses and wiring; repairs locks, handles and security mechanisms. Assists in the planning and scheduling of projects; makes recommendations, prepares plans, identifies equipment and materials needed including budget proposals; oversees and instructs contractors on complex building maintenance projects; ensures adherence to safe work methods, procedures and practices, and participate in the City's After Hours On-Call Surveillance Program, adjusted workweek schedule and may respond to emergency calls during nights, weekends and holiday hours. The incumbent will perform related and peripheral duties as necessary.

Qualifications: A typical way of obtaining the required qualifications is to possess the equivalent of three (3) years of facility maintenance, or related experience, and a High School diploma or GED. Possession of, or ability to obtain, a valid class "C" California driver's license.
