Duties: The Plans Examiner is a Non-Represented position responsible for independent review of complex plans as well as energy, structural, and other calculations; consults with and advises engineers, contractors, architects, designers, and the general public concerning codes, permits, and plan review items; establishes valuations and permit costs for new projects. This classification also requires sound judgment and analysis of problems relating to building construction or grading projects.

Qualifications: Any combination of education and experience that has provided the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for a Plans Examiner. A typical way of obtaining the required qualifications is to possess four (4) years of increasingly responsible experience in building structural design and/or structural plan checking, and a High School diploma or GED with some directly related college level coursework supplemented with specialized training in plans checking, building inspection and code enforcement or a related field.

- Possession of, or ability to obtain within one (1) year of employment, a Plans Examiner Certificate issued by the International Code Council or equivalent.
- Possession of, or ability to obtain, within one (1) year of employment, a Certified Access Specialist (CASP) certification may be required, based upon the needs of the City.
- Possession of, or ability to obtain, a valid class "C" California driver's license.
