



**PER CALIFORNIA STATE LAW ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED**

## **Procedure for Dog License Application**

1. A current rabies vaccination certificate is required to license your dog. Low cost vaccinations are available at local veterinarians or you may attend a vaccine clinic held by Hesperia Veterinary Services every **Wednesday, from 9-11am and 2-4pm**, located at the Animal Control facility at 11011 Santa Fe Ave E, Suite 101, Hesperia, CA 92345.

**No appointment necessary (Wed. clinic)**

**\$6-Wed**

**\$10-Mon/Tues/Thurs/ Fri 8am - 5pm**

2. Complete the application on the back of this form and submit form and fees to Hesperia Animal Control. Fees can be mailed in or brought to Hesperia Animal Control. Do not leave blank spaces or license **cannot** be processed. You **MUST** attach the required certificates to this form to receive a license.

**(Current rabies vaccination certificate, spay/neuter certificate and proof of age 55 or older, if applicable.)**

3. Within 1-2 weeks you will receive your permanent license and tag. If you do not receive your license, call 760-947-1715.

#### **4. License is renewed on a yearly basis.**

Senior Citizen 55 or older and <b><u>altered</u></b> dog	\$ 8.00
Altered Dog	\$ 13.00
Non-Altered Dog	\$ 70.00
Transfer from another Jurisdiction (altered)	\$ 5.00
Transfer from another Jurisdiction (un-altered)	\$ 10.00

***Late penalties will be required if not licensed on time***

Altered dog late penalty	\$ 10.00
Non-Altered dog late penalty	\$ 25.00
