NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Hesperia has prepared its 2014-2015 CDBG Action Plan. The public review and written comment period required under Federal Regulation 24 CFR 91.105(b)(2) begins Monday, April 7, 2014 and runs through Thursday, May 8, 2014.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Hesperia is an entitlement community that participates in the CDBG Program, and anticipates receiving CDBG funding in the amount of \$913,452 for PY 2014-2015. Funding levels may change once HUD releases the final CDBG Allocations. On April 1, 2014, the Hesperia City Council will hold the final public hearing to receive input on the PY 2014-2015 Action Plan, in accordance with HUD regulations. This Plan represents the final year of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan required by HUD and adopted by the Hesperia City Council in program year 2010.

SUMMARY OF THE ONE-YEAR ACTION PLAN:

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015, the City of Hesperia proposes the utilization of CDBG funds to implement the programs and activities listed below. These funding levels below represent the City Council Advisory Committee's recommendation and are subject to change based on the City Council's action at the April 1, 2014 Public Hearing and HUD's release of the final annual allocation amount. Changes to these proposed budgets due the release of the final HUD allocation, as necessary, will be made as described in the PY 2014-2015 Action Plan.
