**NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN** that the City of Hesperia has prepared its revised Citizen Participation Plan available for public review and comment. The public review and written comment period required under Federal Regulation 24 CFR 91.105(b)(2) begins Monday, April 7, 2014 and runs through Thursday, May 8, 2014.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Citizen Participation Plan specifies how the City provides opportunities for citizens to participate in the upcoming development of the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan, 2015-2019 Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice, and 2015-2016 Annual Action Plan—documents that specify how the City expends CDBG funds to benefit the community. The revised Citizen Participation Plan is proposed to replace the current effective plan that was approved by the City Council in 2010. The revised Citizen Participation Plan incorporates regulatory changes enacted by HUD since 2010.
