NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the public review and written comment period required under Federal Regulation 24 CFR 91.105(b)(2) begins Wednesday, April 8, 2015 and runs through Friday, May 8, 2015.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Hesperia is an entitlement community that participates in the CDBG Program, and received CDBG funds on an annual basis. Since the adoption of the 2012-2013 Action Plan, the City has identified one (1) activity that it wishes to cancel (described below). A public hearing and public review period is required in order to approve these proposed changes.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO THE 2012-2013 ACTION PLAN:

The City is proposing to cancel one (1) activity funded during the 2012-2013 program year and funding one (1) new activity during the 2014-2015 program year. These activities are the Intergenerational Community Center Property Acquisition and the City of Hesperia Economic Development Loan Program (EDLP).

The following table outlines the activity budgets that are being modified. These funding levels are subject to change based on the City Council’s action at the April 21, 2015 Public Hearing.
