Solicit citizen participation and public comment on the draft Substantial Amendment to the 2010-2014 Five-Year Consolidated Plan ("Consolidated Plan") and the draft 2012-2013 Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Action Plan ("Action Plan") prepared for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held on Tuesday, April 3, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. in the City of Hesperia Council Chambers. The purpose of the Public hearing is to solicit citizen participation and public comment on the draft Substantial Amendment to the 2010-2014 Five-Year Consolidated Plan ("Consolidated Plan") and the draft 2012-2013 Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Action Plan ("Action Plan") prepared for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Hesperia has prepared its Substantial Amendment to the 2010-2014 Five-Year Consolidated Plan and 2012-2013 CDBG Action Plan. The public review and written comment period required under Federal Regulation 24 CFR 91.105(b)(2) begins Wednesday, April 11, 2012 and runs through Friday, May 11, 2012.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Hesperia is an entitlement community that participates in the CDBG Program, and anticipates receiving CDBG funding in the amount of \$819,934 for PY 2012-2013. On April 3, 2012, the Hesperia City Council will hold the final public hearing to receive input on the PY 2012-2013 Action Plan, in accordance with HUD regulations. This Plan represents the third year of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan required by HUD and adopted by the Hesperia City Council in program year 2010.

In addition, on April 3, 2012, the Hesperia City Council will hold a public hearing to receive input on the Substantial Amendment to the Consolidated Plan, in accordance with HUD regulations. This Substantial Amendment adjusts the City's Consolidated Plan goals and proposed accomplishments for the five-year consolidated planning period to account for reduced CDBG and Redevelopment Agency funding levels. The Substantial Amendment also increases proposed accomplishments for activities the City has exceeded or anticipates exceeding during the five-year consolidated planning period.

SUMMARY OF THE ONE-YEAR ACTION PLAN:

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013, the City of Hesperia proposes the utilization of CDBG funds to implement the programs and activities listed below. These funding levels below represent the City Council Advisory Committees recommendation only and are subject to change based on the City Council's action at the April 3, 2012 Public Hearing.
