**NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Hesperia has prepared its 2013-2014 CDBG Action Plan. The public review and written comment period required under Federal Regulation 24 CFR 91.105(b)(2) begins Thursday, April 11, 2013 and runs through Friday, May 10, 2013.

**BACKGROUND:**

The City of Hesperia is an entitlement community that participates in the CDBG Program, and anticipates receiving CDBG funding in the amount of \$819,934 for PY 2013-2014. Funding levels may be less after congress passes the FY 2013 Continuing Resolution, and may be further reduced by five percent or more due to the sequester. On April 2, 2013, the Hesperia City Council will hold the final public hearing to receive input on the PY 2013-2014 Action Plan, in accordance with HUD regulations. This Plan represents the fourth year of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan required by HUD and adopted by the Hesperia City Council in program year 2010.

**SUMMARY OF THE ONE-YEAR ACTION PLAN:**

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014, the City of Hesperia proposes the utilization of CDBG funds to implement the programs and activities listed below. These funding levels below represent the City Council Advisory Committees recommendation only and are subject to change based on the City Council’s action at the April 2, 2013 Public Hearing and HUD’s release of the final annual allocation amount.
