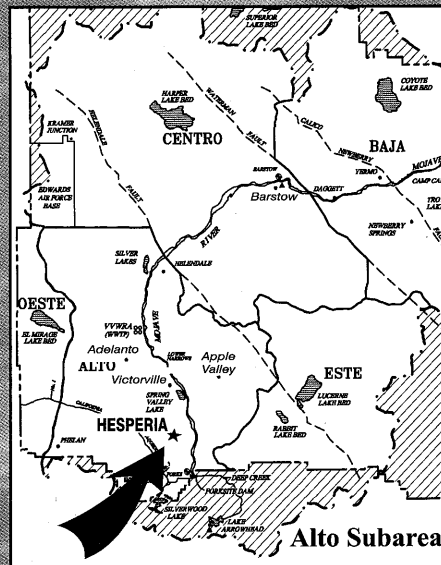




# 2002 Annual Water Quality Report



## **To Our Customers:**

The Hesperia Water District (HWD) is pleased to present to you the 2002 Annual Water Quality Report in compliance with State and Federal law. If you have any questions about this report or about the water provided by HWD, please call 947-1000. The District's trained and certified water professionals strive to provide the highest quality water in compliance with all applicable regulatory standards. All of Hesperia's water supply is extracted from the Alto Subarea of the Mojave River groundwater basin. (Refer to the map located on this page.)

The City Council for the City of Hesperia serves as the Board of Directors for the Hesperia Water District. Board meetings are held in conjunction with the City Council meetings on the first and third Wednesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers located at 15776 Main Street. Meetings are open to the public and we encourage and invite your participation. Additionally, the Public Works Advisory Committee made up of Hesperia citizens provides input on District activities.

In 2001, the Hesperia Water District provided over 14,600 acre-feet of potable water to the City of Hesperia. This equates to approximately five billion gallons of water. The peak day of production was August 18, 2001, during which the District produced over 25 million gallons of water within a twenty-four hour period. During this high usage period, the Hesperia Water District maintained positive water pressures to all service connections.
